



ÓBUDA (OLD BUDA) is the oldest part of Budapest situated in Buda. District 3 lies on the ruins of the huge, ancient military camp of Roman legionaries called Aquincum, the northernmost frontier of the Roman Empire in continental Europe. Consequently, several amphitheatres and artifacts have been unearthed here. Medieval Óbuda used to be a suburb filled with silk refineries and boat factories, forming part of Budapest by the time of its unification in 1873. Óbuda was inhabited mostly by German-speaking Swabian farmers, and, because of its village-like atmosphere, was a favorite place of the *petite bourgeoisie* of Pest for outings.

MARGARET ISLAND is mostly covered by landscape parks and is a popular recreational area. Its medieval ruins are reminders of its importance in the Middle Ages as a religious center. The island spans the area between the Margaret and the Árpád Bridges.

BUDA CASTLE is the historical castle complex of the Hungarian kings, first completed in 1265. It was built on the southern tip of Castle Hill, surrounded by what is known as the Castle District, famous for its Medieval, Baroque and 19th century living quarters and public buildings. Buda Castle is part of the Budapest World Heritage Site.

ABOUT RUDASH THERMAL BATH: The centerpiece of the bath today, the Turkish bath, was built during the 16th century in the period of the Turkish occupation. Below the 10 m diameter dome, sustained by 8 pillars, there is an octagonal pool. Group use on Friday and Saturday nights (10.00 PM — 04.00 AM).

## How to get us with public transportation

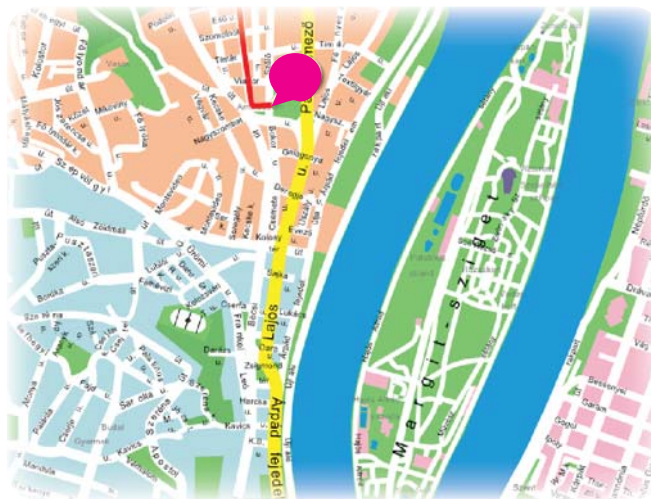
FROM FERIHEGY AIRPORT

We recommend to take the bus #200E to the final stop named *Kőbánya-Kispest*. Then change to the metro line M3 to *Deák tér* where take the line M2 for 2 stops to *Batthyány tér*.

Then you can choose between the HÉV (suburban railway) for 2 stops to *Szépölgyi út* or the buses #160 or #260 to the stop *Nagyszombat utca*.

From the RAILWAY STATION NYUGATI (West) take the bus #206 (from Monday to Friday, from morning to 7:00 PM) or #109 (on Saturday and Sunday and on evening from 7:00 PM) to *Nagyszombat utca*.

From the RAILWAY STATION KELETI (East) and DÉLI (South) take the metro line M2 to *Batthyány tér*. Henceforth see above.



## With taxi and Airport Shuttle from Ferihegy Airport

Take ZONA TAXI on the airport. Fixed price about €24 for 4 people (we are in zone 3).

The AIRPORT SHUTTLE (about €10-12/person). The minibuses handle transfers from the airport to the passenger's home. The service can be ordered personally at the Airport Shuttle Desk located at every terminal. Operating 0-24 hours, with a boarding capacity of 8 to 10 passengers. The minibuses operate as a shared-ride service, meaning passengers travelling to the same region are carried at once.
